



Communication with the School

All of the school children will have a Google Workspace account and you can send a private message to your child's class teacher via that account. Please let her know if it's urgent or not and a rough idea what it is you'd like to discuss.

Google Classrooms

Your child's class teacher will schedule a list of work to appear on their Google Classroom each Sunday evening. This will be a an outline of the work that will be covered in class that week. We hope this will help if you need to keep them home for any reason, they can stay up to date with their classwork and not feel like they are falling behind. Before and Afterschool Service

Before and Afterschool Service will be available from Tuesday morning. Any parent wishing to avail of morning or afternoon sessions should submit their details on this form: https://forms.gle/Ut2PUNeTC4sjFL9aA

Once we have an idea of numbers we will contact you directly with details of fees etc. Morning session will be from 7.50am to 8.50am and afternoon session will run from 1.30pm to 5.30pm. There will be flexibility within the times of the afternoon session. Both sessions will be based in the classroom closest to the school gate. Where possible, the children will spend much of the time outdoors and strict protocols will be in place to carefully manage hygiene, ventilation and record keeping for the purposes of contact tracing. The school teachers will supervise the morning session and Caitlín Ní Fhlatharta will be in charge of the afternoon session. Caitlín is also employed in the school as our Cúntóir Teanga this year, welcome Caitlín.

Medical Conditions/Administration of Medicines

Please make the school aware of any medical conditions that your child may have, and what if any support your child may need in its regard. If your child requires medication at school you must submit a new form each year. See the policy on the school website and submit Appendix 1, 2 or 3 to the school as soon as possible. If you'd like a hard copy, please call Susan and she'll send it home in your child's bag on Tuesday.

School Lunches/ Allergies

There are a number of children who have serious allergies to peanuts, hazelnuts, sunflower seeds and pistachio. This list is not exclusive and may be updated at any point in the year when needs be. These allergies can result in trouble breathing, feeling lightheaded and in some cases we have children who would suffer anaphylaxis. If your child has any serious reactions to other foods/allergies it is important that you let us know. N.B-We ask parents to not to include sunflower seeds, peanuts, hazelnuts, pistachio, mayonnaise, chocolate or coleslaw as it could affect the children with allergies in the school. We appreciate your continued support with this. Please also adhere carefully to the school's Healthy Eating Policy available on the school website.

We would like to extend a warm welcome to the new children and parents starting with us in Boin Dé this year. We know you'll have a wonderful time meeting new friends and learning through play with Muinteoir Niamh and Muinteoir Emer. The morning session is full but there are still a few places available in the afternoon session if you know anyone who would like to enrol.

Afterschool activities

We are awaiting clarification on whether afterschool activities such as Stretch N Grow and music lessons can be resumed. We know that you'll all give your support to those groups as soon as they are back up and running after a very difficult period for their businesses.

School Bus

If your child is taking the bus for the first time this year, please notify the school so that we can keep an eye out for them. 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Footwear/Clothing • Children must avail of velcro footwear in cases where they are still learning how to master shoelaces. • Please wear runners daily - to enable frequent activity outside, as happened last year there will be a lot of walks and adventures in nature.

If you need to collect your child early during the school day the procedure will be as follows • Ring the school to inform them of the situation, (the day before if possible) • When you arrive, phone the school and your child will be brought out to the small gate • Your child should be made aware of the early pick up.


