Please let her know if it's urgent or not and a rough idea what it is you'd like to discuss.

### Cruinnithe Tuistí / Parent Teacher Meetings

We will hold parent-teacher meetings online next week on Tuesday 19th, Wednesday 20th and Thursday 21st. Meetings will be in your child's google classroom, as last year. Please do not enter the meeting if you see another parent is already in there, instead wait until you see that it's just the teacher. The timeslots will each be ten minutes. As the end of your slot approaches if you feel there is more you would like to discuss, please mention this to the teacher and they will arrange to meet you again after mid-term or to give you a call. You will receive an email this Wednesday with assigned timeslots. We understand that the time assigned may not suit. If the time assigned does not suit, we ask you to email Susan at runai@scoilbhride1862.ie. She will notify the teachers that you can't attend and Susan will be in touch with you after the mid-term to schedule another time. Please don't ask to swap times for next week. Teachers will have posted some general class information on the classroom stream before the meetings, please have a look through this as it may help answer some general questions.

#### **Before and Afterschool Service**

Before and Afterschool Services are available in school, covering from 7.50am up until 5.30pm. There is a charge of €5 per child per morning, or €20 for the full week. The afternoon charges are as follows:
